



Tameside Sport & Physical Activity Awards 2022 - Guidance Notes for Nominations

All nominees, other than the Club/Group of the Year, must be individuals.

All nominations (excluding Unsung Hero) should describe the period within the 12 months prior, and up to, the closing date – **Sunday 7th August 2022**.

Changing Lifestyle Award

This award is for a person who has used physical activity to transform their lifestyle for the better.

The nominee should be a permanent resident in the local area – Tameside.

Community Club or Group of the Year

This award is for a community sports club or physical activity group which has had an impact in their local community in the given time period.

The club must be based and run from the borough being nominated - Tameside.

Young Sports Achiever of the Year

This award is for young athletes (aged under 18) who are not professionally funded, who have had significant success in their sport throughout the year (must be born after 31st December 2003).

The nominee should be a permanent resident in the local area – Tameside.

Unsung Hero Award

This award recognises long term volunteers (over 10 years) who have made a significant difference over that timeframe.

The volunteering must take place in the borough they are nominated for – Tameside.

Alex Williams Volunteer of the Year

This award is for volunteers who have given up their time to volunteer over the past 12 months.

The volunteering must take place in the borough they are nominated for – Tameside.

School Commitment to PE and Sport

This award recognises schools that have gone above and beyond in respect to incorporating activity into a school day for their pupils and staff.

This is based upon achievements in the academic year - primary or secondary eligible.

School must be based in the borough being nominated for – Tameside.

Disabled Physical Activity Champion

This award is for people who have a disability and have shown significant success in their sport or chosen physical activity throughout the year. The nominee should be a permanent resident in the local area – Tameside.

Inclusion & Diversity Award

This award is for a community sports club or community physical activity group that has had an impact in working with people from under-represented groups in reducing inequalities by providing pathways and access for people to participate/volunteer in sport, physical or social activity.

Examples of inclusive work could be with the following groups of people – women & girls, people with disabilities, low-socioeconomic groups, and people from black, Asian and minority ethnic backgrounds and Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual or Transgender (LGBTQ+)

Coach or Instructor of the Year

This award recognises an individual that has used sport or physical activity within their voluntary role to have a positive impact on any of the following outcomes for their local community:

- Physical wellbeing
- Mental wellbeing
- Individual development
- Social and community development
