Empowering Tameside communities through sport & physical activity

Tackling inequalities

- Equipment Bursary Fund has supported 24 young people with sports equipment creating a pathway in to sports clubs and groups.
- Partnered with 14 sports clubs/physical activity groups for holiday camp delivery within the Fuel4Fun HAF programme resulting in 4,780 attendances.

Increase participation

- Membership and development of the Active Tameside Sport & Physical Activity network, now at 123 affiliated clubs and groups receiving 1-1 support.
- Supported "Have a go" days at various local sports clubs with over 300 attendances.
- Created club to school links with 23 sports clubs and physical activity groups.





Workforce/Volunteering development

- Successful placement of 7 regular volunteers referred into sports clubs.
- The Networks Coach bursary has supported 124 coaches/volunteers to achieve NGB qualifications and mandatory courses.

Funding to grow club/groups

 Leveraged £60k of external grants, including funding for Priory Tennis Club, Hollingworth Cricket Club and Hattersley F.C.

Accreditations and raising the standards

- Delivery of Active Tameside Sport & Physical Activity awards with 100 nominees
- Denton Synchro Club won the 2022
